DECATUR, Ga.—DeKalb County District 4 Commissioner Steve Bradshaw has partnered with several local organizations to present the fourth annual Refugee Career Summit on Friday, Sept. 20, 2019, from 11 a.m.-1 p.m. at Georgia State University's Clarkston Campus located at 555 North Indian Creek Drive, Clarkston, GA 30021.
